Through the CommunitySavers Program, property owners, community managers and income-eligible customers can receive energy-saving products for their homes, along with incentives when they make eligible energy-efficient upgrades. The Multifamily and Single Family Programs are offered by Ameren Missouri in partnership with Spire.

CommunitySavers Single Family Program

Ameren Missouri's CommunitySavers Single Family Program is designed to help income-eligible homeowners, renters, and housing organizations lower their energy bills and reduce maintenance costs. Starting with a no-cost home energy assessment, a program representative will determine your home's energy saving potential, install measures such as light bulbs, and schedule installation of larger equipment for which your home may be eligible. In the Single Family Program, all services and upgrades are provided at no cost for eligible customers.

CommunitySavers Multifamily Program

Saving energy and money is easy for owners or managers of multifamily properties with Ameren Missouri's CommunitySavers Multifamily Program. The Multifamily Program is designed to help multifamily property owners, managers and their income-eligible residents lower their energy bills, reduce maintenance costs and improve equipment reliability. Energy-efficient upgrades are provided at no cost to eligible multifamily tenant units. Eligible property owners can receive rebates/reimbursement in the form of an incentive check upon completion of their project.

CommunitySavers Program Eligibility

CommunitySavers Single Family Program: eligible homes must have four or fewer attached or detached living units and meet the income criteria below.

CommunitySavers Multifamily Program: eligible buildings must have three or more attached living units and meet the eligibility criteria below.

The residents who occupy eligible properties must meet at least one of the three following income requirements:

- 1. Participation in federal, state, or local subsidized housing program.
- 2. Proof of resident income levels at or below 80% of area median income (AMI) or 200% of federal poverty level.
- 3. Fall within a census tract included on Ameren Missouri's list of eligible low-income census tracts.
